To extend the life of your furniture, follow these guidelines:

Avoid placing furniture in direct sunlight. Try to keep the humidity constant. High humidity causes the wood to swell, while low humidity causes wood to lose moisture and shrink. Extreme changes can result

Always dust with a soft, clean cloth moistened with a fine furniture polish. Dry dusting can scratch the surface. Never use soap and water. Water can penetrate the surface, causing damage. Remove liquid spills promptly.

Use the same type of polish consistently. Furniture will appear cloudy or streaky if oil-based and wax-based polishes are interchanged. Spray the surface evenly, but not too generously. For wood trim, spray polish on the cloth first and then dust. Wipe in a circular motion to clean and loosen the old polish. Buff until completely dry for a beautiful shine and a smudge-resistant finish.
